SUBJECT: Hearing Stream 8 – Urban Subdivision s42A Report – Missed Further

Submission Points.

- 1. The purpose of this memorandum is to inform the Hearing Panel of 11 further submission points that were missed in the Urban Subdivision s42A report and provide an update to Appendix B to address these.
- 2. The further submission points that were missed in the report are as follows:
 - a. David Cowley [FS41] on Christchurch City Council [360.2] and Environment Canterbury [316.126, 316.127, 316.128 and 316.129]
 - b. Richard and Geoff Spark [FS37] on Bellgrove Rangiora Limited [408.25]
 - c. Malcolm Dartnell [FS4] on Rick Allaway and Lionel Larsen [236.11]
 - d. Mark McKitterick [FS2] on Mark McKitterick and Chloe Chai [256.20]
 - e. Christchurch International Airport Limited [FS80] on Environment Canterbury [316.125, 316.126 and 316.132]
- 3. The missed points were noticed in a further check of all original submission points and all further submission points across all s42A reports released to date.
- 4. All the further submitters listed above had further submission points on other provisions within the Urban Subdivision Report and therefore were sent the report. No submitter raised the missed points as an issue at the hearing, or since the hearing. The s42A report stated that recommendations in relation to further submissions reflect the recommendations on the relevant primary submission¹. No primary submissions were missed. My recommendations remain unchanged. For these reasons, it is considered that no submitter is unfairly disadvantaged by this.

I also recommend the insertion of 'Natural Hazards' within the list of 'other potentially relevant District Plan provisions within the SUB-Chapter Introduction to cross reference the NH-Chapter.	Yes
