MEMORANDUM OF COUNSEL FOR KĀINGA ORA – HOMES AND COMMUNITIES

- Counsel refer to Minute #27 of the Independent Hearing Panel dated 7 June 2024.
- In that Minute, the Panel has rescheduled a number of hearing streams, including Stream 7, and has asked submitters to advise the Hearings Administrator of any concerns.
- 3. One consequence of that change is that, on the current timetable directions, the release of the section 42A report will coincide with a period of leave for one of the Kāinga Ora expert witnesses, affecting their ability to prepare evidence.
- Another consequence is that a further expert witness for Kāinga Ora (who will be addressing financial contributions) is only available on 17 September 2024, during the Stream 7B hearings.
- 5. Counsel also understand, from involvement in earlier hearings, that the section 42A report for Stream 7 is substantially complete (as amendments will be introduced through Stream 7 have been referenced in earlier section 42A reports).
- 6. Counsel seek the following directions:
 - a. that the witnesses for Kāinga Ora be granted an extension to file expert evidence to 11 September 2024; and
 - b. that Kāinga Ora be permitted to appear once (across both Streams) on 17 September 2024.
- In the alternative to the direction sought in 6(b) above, counsel will need to seek leave to present its case over two days.
