

Watermain Undergrounding Townsend Road

We are planning work on Townsend Road.

The water main that crosses Southbrook Stream is at risk of being struck by traffic as Townsend Road becomes busier.

The work will include

Modifying the watermain so it crosses under Southbrook Stream rather than over it. This will protect a critical stormwater asset and future proof the site by creating additional space for the potential widening, or replacement of the adjacent culvert.

Timing of work

This work will begin the week of 20 May 2024 and is expected to be completed by the end of June.

Traffic impacts

During construction Townsend Road will be down to one lane between South Belt and Fernside Road with temporary traffic signals in place.

Your kerbside collections will remain unchanged. Please ensure your bag or bins are in their usual spot on collection day.

Hours

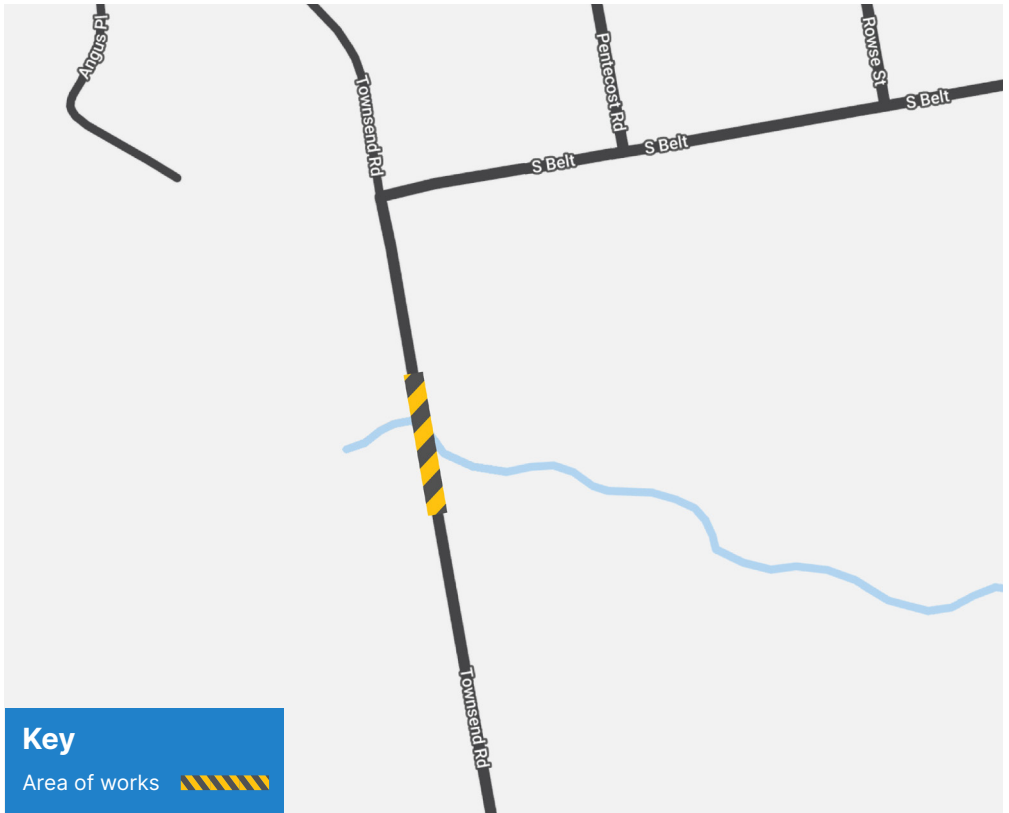
