

How to place your bins for kerbside collection





1. Place your bin: Half a metre apart from other bins. This allows our truck's arm to clamp on to a single bin without issue. **TIP: Think a bin width apart.**





2. Place your bin: On the kerb facing the street so our truck's arm can reach your bins.

Do you live up a long driveway or in a cul-de-sac??

If you share a long driveway with multiple properties or live in a cul-de-sac, take your bins to a kerbside location that the truck can access.

The service will not collect from private lanes.







Making these small changes saves the truck driver a huge amount of time and stress.

Do the right thing and help your local kerbside collection driver.



3. Place your bin: One metre clear of obstructions like poles, mailboxes, trees and parked cars. Just think... If the bin tipped over, would it hit an obstruction? If so, it is too close.



4. Place your bin: Three metres clear of powerlines or low hanging trees. The truck's arm needs enough space to lift your bin up towards the truck. It pays to look up!
